

Calibrone Hooklength Tyer



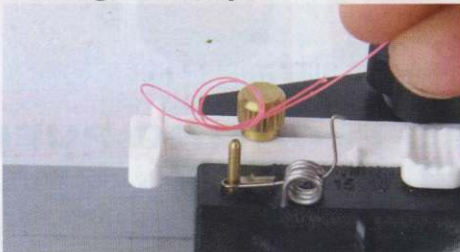
The Calibrone Hooklength Tyer from Stonfo can be used to tie hooks and loops, while the ruler measures the exact length of your hooklink. Feeder and Match anglers can use it to tie hooklinks from 200mm to over a meter long and exactly the right

length every time. With a very small modification using a snap swivel it can also tie hooklinks for Bank Anglers.

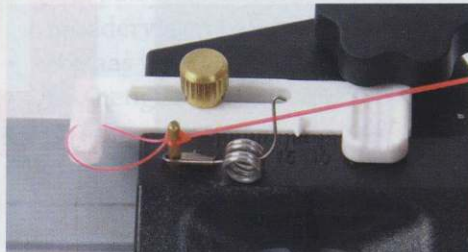
Feeder and Match Anglers: first use the loop tyer to tie a small loop on your line; move the measurement of the machine to the length you want.

Bank Anglers: first tie a power swivel to the hooklink then hook the swivel on the safety snap on the machine and set the desired length, then use the hooktyer to tie the line on the hook. The tyer uses the "snell knot" on the hook - a very strong and reliable knot.

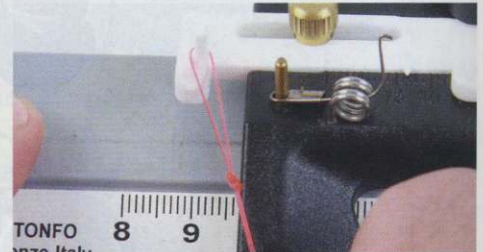
Making the loop:



1 Set the loopyer to the desired setting.



2 Make a standard figure-8 knot, place over loopyer.

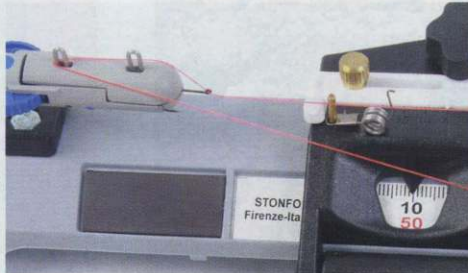


3 Lift the knot out of the steel pin and tension against the white hard plastic pin.

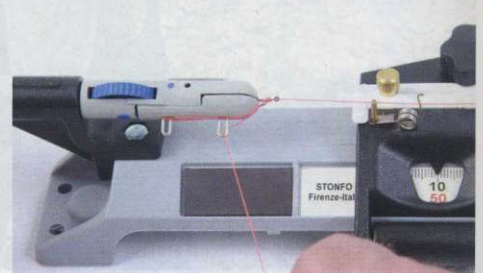
Tying the hooklength:



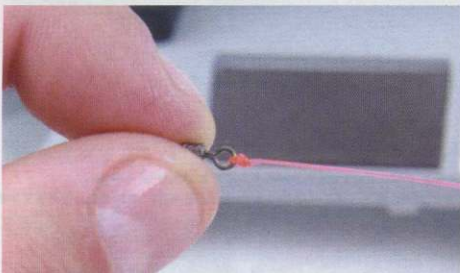
1 Longer than 45cm - Set the boom to e.g. 50cm, hook the loop onto the spring.



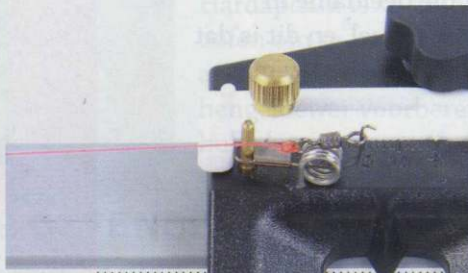
2 Put the line through the hook eye, or against the shaft (spaded)



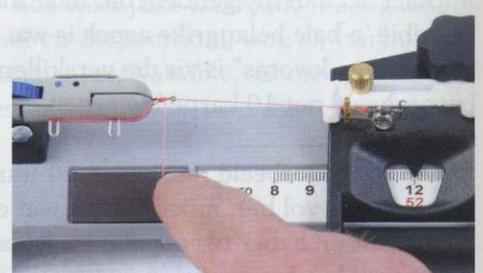
3 Use the hooktyer to snell a neat knot.



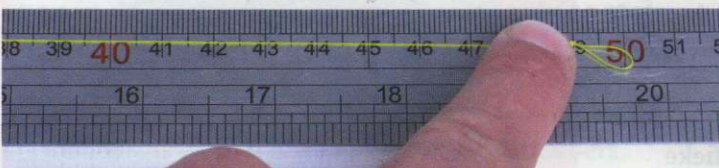
4 Bank angling hooklengths - tie a power swivel on.



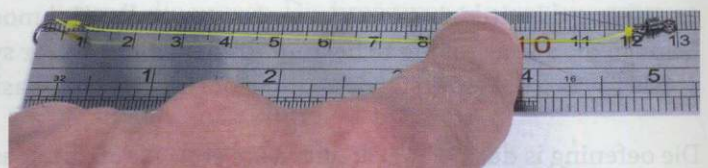
5 Use the modified snap swivel to hook your swivel on.



6 Use the hooktyer to snell the knot and pull it tight for a perfect snell knot.



A perfect 500mm hookline.



A perfect 12cm hookline, with a swivel.
